Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 8 of the Guardian & Wards Act, 1890 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for custody of the minor from Sangrur to Mohali.

It is also urged that the petitioner is posted as a teacher in a government school at Kurali, Mohali. Besides this, distance between Mohali and Sangrur is approximately 150 kilometers and it would be very difficult for the petitioner to perform journey to this extent, on each and every date of hearing keeping in view the fact the son of the petitioner is critically suffering from kidney infection who is taking treatment at PGI, Chandigarh.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 8 of the Act pending at

Sangrur is transferred to Mohali. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
