Reply on behalf of the respondents has not been filed though the respondents had put in appearance on 16.12.2013. Even today counsel for the respondents has sought adjournment for this purpose. Request for adjournment for filing reply, thus, is declined.

2. Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of petition under Section 6 of the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956 read with provisions of Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 (for short, the Act) filed by the respondents, who are parents-in-law of the petitioner, from Ajnala, District Amritsar to Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur as the petitioner, who is widow, has been residing alongwith her parents and a minor son born on 22.9.2010 at Garhshankar, which is approximately 150 Kms. away from Ajnala.

3. It is also urged that the minor son, namely, Sushant is studying at BVS Model School, Ror Majara, Garhshankar since April 2013 and it would be very inconvenient for the petitioner as also the minor child to attend the court proceedings at Ajnala.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 6 of the Act pending before Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Ajnala, District Amritsar is transferred to District Judge, Hoshiarpur who may further assign the same to the court of competent jurisdiction at Garhshankar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
