Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 10 of the Indian Divorce Act, 1869 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from Ropar to Ferozepur.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. as also proceedings in a petition for restitution of conjugal rights at Ferozepur. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 200 kilometers from Ferozepur to Ropar on each and every date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 10 of the Indian Divorce Act, 1869 pending at Ropar is transferred to District Judge, Ferozepur who

may assign it to any other competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 23.4.2015.

The petition stands disposed of.
