Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from Patiala to Panipat.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Panipat. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 170 kilometers from Panipat to Patiala on each and every date of hearing, along with her minor daughter, who is aged four and a half years.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Patiala is transferred to District Judge, Panipat. Both

the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
