Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Barnala to Patiala.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing criminal proceedings before Women Cell at Nabha as also under Section 125 Cr.P.C. Besides this, distance between Patiala and Barnala is 150 kilometers and it will be very difficult for the petitioner to travel this much distance one way on each and every date of hearing, more so when there is threat perception to her at the hands of her in-laws.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage

Act, 1955 pending at Barnala is transferred to Patiala. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
