Petitioner, namely, Parmila has directed this petition under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code, seeking transfer of divorce petition i.e. HMA No.103/2013, pending in the Court of Mr. Kamal Kant, ADJ, Rohtak, titled as "Pawan Vs. Parmila", to the Court of District Judge, Jhajjar.

It is submitted that the divorce petition has been filed by the husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, which is pending in the Court of Additional District Judge, Rohtak. The petitioner has a son, namely, Shivam, aged 03 years and is residing at Jhajjar. It is very difficult for the petitioner to carry the minor son at Rohtak on each and every date of hearing.

Another petition under Section 125 of the Criminal Procedure

Code, and a complaint under Domestic Violence Act, 2005, are also pending in the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jhajjar.

Notice of the present petition was given to the respondent, who in spite of service has not appeared.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstance, it is a fit case to allow the petition. In these circumstances, case stands transferred from the Court of Additional District Judge, Rohtak, to the Court of District Judge, Jhajjar. The District Judge, Jhajjar, may keep the file himself or may entrust the same to any Additional District Judge, Jhajjar for disposal.

Petition stands disposed of.
