There is no appearance on behalf of the respondent though earlier he was represented through Mr.A.D.S.Sukhija, Advocate. As such, the respondent is proceeded against ex-parte.

1. Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, by the husband, respondent herein, from District Kurukshetra to Chandigarh as the petitioner is presently residing at House No.125, Village Kajheri, U.T., Chandigarh.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed cases against her husband which are pending adjudication in the Court at Chandigarh, are as follows:

- (i) Criminal case i.e. FIR No.15 dated 12.01.2013 under Section 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station, Sector-36, Chandigarh.
- (ii) An application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner against the respondent.
- (iii) A case under Section 12 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, filed by petitioner against the respondent.

- (iv) A petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the petitioner against the respondent.

3. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

4. Sequelly, the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending before learned Additional District Judge, Kurukshetra, District Kurukshetra is transferred to District Judge, Chandigarh. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

5. Disposed of accordingly.
