Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Karnal to Hisar.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing criminal proceedings inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC at Hisar. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to undertake journey of 120 kilometers from Hisar to Karnal on each and every date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Karnal is transferred to Family Court, Hisar . Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 12.6.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
