SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The petitioner- husband invoking the provisions of Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure has sought transfer of Civil suit No. 671 dated 19.08.2013 titled as “**Meena Sharma Advocate Vs. Paramjit Singh**” filed by the respondent -wife, from the Court of Civil Judge(Sr. Division), Moga to any other Court of competent jurisdiction out of District Moga.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that without going into the merits of the case he has instructions to state that the respondent has no objection if the case pending before Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Moga is transferred to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also no objection with the transfer of the case to Jagraon.

Accordingly, the civil suit pending before the Civil Judge (Sr. Division) Moga is withdrawn from the Court of Civil Judge (Sr. Division) Moga and is transferred to Civil Judge(Sr. Division) Jagraon for trial as per law. The file shall be sent by the trial Court to District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana within

two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, who will entrust the same to the Court of Civil Judge(Sr. Division) Jagraon for trial.

The parties are directed to appear before the District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana on 26.11.2015.
