Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

The respondent, who was appearing in person, has not put in appearance today. There is no representation on his behalf. Proceeded against ex-parte.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Hisar to Rohtak.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Rohtak. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 100 kilometers from Rohtak to Hisar on each and every date of hearing, along with her two minor children, as also she has to fulfill her job obligations.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner

as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Hisar is transferred to Rohtak. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
