Impugned in the present Regular Second Appeal is the judgment and decree dated 01.10.2014 passed by learned District Judge, SBS Nagar, Nawanshahr affirming the judgment and decree dated 15.11.2012 passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), SBS Nagar whereby the suit filed by the plaintiff was dismissed.

It comes out that the plaintiff had challenged the Will

dated 14.08.2003 executed by his father Ananta Singh whereby he was excluded from succession. The Will in question is a registered Will. The findings of fact have been recorded that due execution of Will has been proved. The findings have been affirmed in appeal. No substantial question of law arises. Hence, the appeal stands dismissed.
