This order will dispose of a bunch appeals bearing RSA Nos. 1377, 1416 to 1418 and 1420 of 2014, as the issue involved in all the appeals is common.

The defendants are before this court against concurrent findings of fact recorded by both the courts below, whereby the suit filed by the respondent for declaration was decreed. Nine civil suits were decided by a common judgment of the trial court dated 23.10.2010, against which appeals were filed before the lower appellate court. Those were also clubbed and decided vide common judgment dated 28.1.2014 by the learned lower appellate court.

It is not disputed by learned counsel for the parties that three of the appeals against the judgment dated 28.1.2014, passed by the learned lower appellate court, were dismissed by this court vide judgment dated 19.3.2015 in RSA No. 2839 of 2014—Ram Kumar and others v. Dera Basau Puri.

For the detailed reasons recorded in Ram Kumar's case (supra), I do not find that any substantial question of law arises in the present set of appeals. The same are, accordingly, dismissed.
