The instant review application has been filed for reviewing the order dated 25.09.2012 passed in CWP No. 15543 of 2004.

Learned counsel for the petitioner raised a contention that the writ petition in this case was not considered on merit. The petitioner has a right to be heard.

It needs to be mentioned that when the notice of motion was issued, even in the index, against Note No. 4 'any other case', it was stated that notice of motion has been issued in CWP No. 5662 of 1986 and CWP No. 7766 of 2004.

CWP No. 15543 of 2004 filed by the petitioner, has been

decided along with CWP No. 7766 of 2004 titled '**Ram Saran and others Vs. The Commissioner and Secretary to Government Haryana, Rehabilitation Department, Chandigarh and others**' and 06 other Civil writ petitions by a common judgment recorded in CWP No. 7766 of 2004.

The Civil Writ Petition No. 7766 of 2004 has been decided by relying upon the Full Bench decision of this Court dated 16.07.2010 rendered in CWP No. 5662 of 1986 titled '**Niranjan Kaur and others Vs. FCR, Punjab**'.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for reviewing the order dated 25.09.2012.

Along with the review application, an application has also been filed seeking condonation of delay of 186 days in filing the review application. No cogent ground has been given for condoning the delay.

Resultantly, the review application as well as the application for condonation of delay are dismissed being devoid of merit.
