[1] On 12.02.2015, this appeal was ordered to be shown in urgent list for 24.02.2015. On the adjourned date, none appeared and in the interest of justice case was adjourned for 27.02.2015. Thereafter, on 27.02.2015 and 13.03.2015, the case was adjourned on the request of learned counsel for the appellant despite the fact that the case was shown in urgent list. On 07.05.2015, none appeared and the case was adjourned for 13.07.2015. On 13.07.2015, none appeared even on second call. The case was adjourned for 12.10.2015. On 12.10.2015, none appeared and this Court passed the following order:-

“Perusal of orders on record reveals that none has appeared on number of occasions in this appeal. Repeated adjournments have been taken. Today also despite three pass-overs none has appeared to address arguments.

In the interest of justice, last opportunity is granted to the

appellant to argue appeal on 28.11.2015.”

[2] Today also despite repeated calls since morning, none has come forward to attend this case. It appears that from the very inception the appellant is reluctant and is not interested in pursuing this appeal.

Faced with no alternative, this appeal is dismissed for want of prosecution.
