This Court while issuing notice of motion on 05.05.2014 also noticed the prayer of the appellants made in the application i.e. CM No.5569-C of 2014 for withdrawing the suit with liberty to file a fresh one in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the appellants contends that the appellants-plaintiffs had filed a suit for partition. However, the trial Court dismissed the suit on ground of non-joinder of necessary parties and appeal filed against the suit was also dismissed.

Learned counsel for the appellants seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the suit with a permission to file fresh, if permissible

in accordance with law.

In view of the prayer made by the learned counsel for the appellants, appellants are permitted to withdraw the suit with a permission to file the same, if permissible in accordance with law.

The present appeal is also ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn .
