just exceptions.

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Counsel for the appellant-plaintiff states that a
compromise has been entered into between the appellant-plaintiff
and the respondent-defendants. The affidavit of Sucha Singh son of
Jassa Singh, resident of village Chak Misri Khan, Tehsil Ajnala,
District Amritsar, has been placed on record.

Counsel for the respondent-defendants has identified and

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accepted the fact that an affidavit has indeed been given by Sucha Singh son of Jassa Singh who is the General Power of Attorney holder for Kharak Singh and Ganda Singh sons of Ishar Singh. On the basis of compromise entered into between the parties, counsel for the parties state that the decree passed by the Lower Appellate Court may be set aside and the decree passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ajnala, dated 11.09.2012 may be upheld.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the parties and keeping in view the compromise which has been entered into between the parties as has been asserted, especially the statements made by them i.e. Jasbir Kaur wife of Charanjit Singh and Sucha Singh son of Jassa Singh, the present appeal is allowed as per the compromise entered into between the parties upholding the decree dated 11.09.2012 passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ajnala.

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In view of the order passed in the main appeal, the present application has become infructuous.

Disposed of as such.
