Impugned in the present regular second appeal is the judgment and decree dated 23.12.2013 passed by learned Addl. District Judge, Rewari, affirming the judgment and decree dated 29.05.2012 passed by learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Rewari, vide which the suit of the plaintiffs-appellants for declaration with all consequential benefits, was dismissed.

Briefly stated that the plaintiff-appellant had challenged the order dated 17.03.2003 passed by the defendants vide which after conducting regular inquiry, one annual increment with temporary effect was stopped. The departmental appeal against the said order was dismissed on 18.04.2003. Accordingly, the appellant filed the suit for declaration with all consequential relief, which was also dismissed by the lower court and was affirmed in appeal by the first appellate

court.

Learned counsel for the appellant has argued that the charges against the appellant are merely on the basis of suspicion. He was not demanding money from the driver of TATA-709.

In this case, report was made by the DSP, Rewari that the present appellant had come to demand money from the driver of TATA-709 and on seeing them sitting in the vehicle, he went away.

It has also been argued that the evidence has not been properly appreciated.

After going through the judgments of both the courts below, I am of the view that these are the findings of facts. No substantial question of law arises in the present appeal.

Accordingly, the present regular second appeal stands dismissed.
