Learned counsel for the appellant states that in the earlier suit, the plaintiff was granted the relief but due to wrong legal advice, the present suit was filed again, which was dismissed on the ground that it was barred under Order II, Rule 2 CPC as the relief has already been granted to the plaintiff.

In these circumstances, the plaintiff wishes to withdraw the present appeal as well as the suit filed before the lower court without any permission to file fresh one.

In view of the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the suit filed by the plaintiff before the lower court is dismissed as withdrawn. Consequently, the present regular second appeal also stands dismissed as withdrawn.
