On February 2, 2015 this Court had passed the following order:-

“As per office report, respondents No.1 & 2 have been served through Clerks. Respondent No.4(a) is reported to have died and respondents No.4(b), 4(c) & 4(d) are found to be not residing at the given addresses. Learned counsel for the appellant prays for and is granted two weeks time to resort to necessary measures to ensure service of unserved respondents.

Upon compliance, let notice be issued to the unserved respondents for 24.08.2015.”

Office report indicates that notices could not be issued to the unserved respondents as counsel for the appellant did not furnish the correct address. It appears that even no application to bring on record the LRs of respondent No.4(a) has been moved, so far. None has caused appearance on behalf of the appellant to pursue the matter. That being so, the Court is choice-less but to dismiss the petition for non-prosecution.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
