Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce from Ludhiana to Bathinda.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Bathinda. Besides this, distance between Bathinda and Ludhiana is approximately 150 kilometers and it would be very difficult for the petitioner to perform journey to this extent, on each and every date of hearing, particularly when she has to look after her five and half year old daughter.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Ludhiana is transferred to Bathinda. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
