Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Patiala to Ludhiana as the petitioner is residing with her parents at Ludhiana which is more than 200 Kms away from Patiala.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Ludhiana. Besides this, she has also filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Ludhiana and has also made a criminal complaint before the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana against the husband-respondent and his family members.

3. No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.
5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Patiala is transferred to District Judge, Ludhiana. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.
6. Disposed of accordingly.
