Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Jagadhri to Amritsar as the petitioner is residing with her parents and minor daughter aged 5 years at Amritsar which is approximately 309 Kms. away from Jagadhri.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Amritsar. Besides this, she has also filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Amritsar against the husband-respondent.

3. No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as

also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri is transferred to District Judge, Amritsar for further transfer of the same to a court of competent jurisdiction under him. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
