Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Jalandhar to S.B.S. Nagar (Nawanshahr) as the petitioner is residing with her parents and infant son aged 4 months, at Nawanshahr which is approximately 90 Kms. away from Jalandhar.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a criminal complaint (Annexure P-1) on 21.10.2014 before the police against the respondent-husband and his family members, which is still pending for enquiry at S.B.S. Nagar (Nawanshahr).

3. No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as

also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jalandhar is transferred to District Judge, S.B.S. Nagar (Nawanshahr) for further transfer of the same to any court of competent jurisdiction. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
