Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Ludhiana to Jalandhar.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. as also criminal proceedings in an FIR inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC at Jalandhar. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 80 kilometers from Jalandhar to Ludhiana on each and every date of hearing when she has also to take care of her minor son of one and a half year old.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner

as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Ludhiana is transferred to Jalandhar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
