Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 17-A of East Punjab Urban Rent Restriction Act, 1949 for transfer of Rent Appeal No.0000150/2014, RT No.01 dated 11.07.2014, titled as Manmohan Singh versus Kashmiri Lal, pending in the Court of Addl. District Judge (Fast Track Court), Bathinda to any other Appellate Authority of District Bathinda.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kashish Garg, Advocate, has appeared and filed power of Attorney on behalf of respondent.

Service is complete.

Learned counsel for respondent does not want to file reply to the instant petition. He states that he has no objection if the said appeal is transferred from the Court of Addl. District Judge (Fast Track Court), Bathinda to some other Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that if the said appeal is transferred to some other Court then he will not press the allegation whatever levelled in the instant petition.

Keeping in view the fact that learned counsel for the respondent has no objection in transferring the appeal; without going into the allegations which the learned counsel for the petitioner is not pressing and in the interest of justice, the instant petition is accepted. The said rent appeal, pending in the Court of Additional District Judge (Fast Track Court), Bathinda, is transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Bathinda, who can keep the said file with him/her or can transfer it to some other competent Court.
