Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 (1)(i)(a) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce from Hisar to Kaithal.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings in a civil suit as also under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at Guhla, District Kaithal. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 130 kilometers from Kaithal to Hisar on each and every date of hearing, especially when she has to look after her three minor children.

No notice is being issued to the respondents in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondents in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13(1)((i)(a) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending before District Judge, Family Court, Hisar is transferred to District Judge, Kaithal. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
