Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from the court of District Judge, Hisar to the court of District Judge, Sirsa.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband and his family members are facing criminal proceedings inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC at Sirsa. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 100 kilometers all alone from Sirsa to Hisar on each and every date of hearing, specifically keeping in view the fact that she is a poor lady.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Hisar is transferred to Sirsa. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
