Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from Jalandhar to Hoshiarpur.

It is also urged that the petitioner is a poor lady having no source of income, having to sustain along with her mother on the family pension of her father. Otherwise also, the respondent-husband is living abroad, i.e., at Bahrain, and it will hardly matter for him if the instant proceedings are conducted at Hoshiarpur. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 46 kilometers all alone from Jalandhar to Hoshiarpur on each and every date of hearing in the eventuality when there is none in the family to accompany her.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Jalandhar is transferred to Hoshiarpur. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
