Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from Fatehgarh Sahib to Patiala.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing criminal complaint No.32 as also under the provisions of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Patiala in addition to two criminal revision petitions filed at the behest of the petitioner against the respondent-husband. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 60 kilometers from Patiala to Fatehgarh Sahib on each and every date of hearing, when she is apprehending imminent threat to her life and limb.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequely, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending Fatehgarh Sahib is transferred to Patiala. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
