Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short “the Act”) filed by the respondent-husband for restoration of restitution of conjugal rights from Barnala to Malerkotla.

It is urged that the petitioner-wife has filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Malerkotla. It is also urged that petitioner-wife is having minor child with her and it is very difficult for her to travel 75 kilometers from Malerkotla to Barnala on each and every date of hearing.

No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner

as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Civil Judge (Senior Division) Barnala is transferred to District Judge Sangrur who may assign it to the court of competent jurisdiction. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
