Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Amritsar to Mohali as the petitioner is residing alongwith her son and daughter at Mohali.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife is 55 years of age and has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Mohali.

3. No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before Additional District Judge, Amritsar is transferred to District Judge,

Mohali. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
