Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from Mohali to Ludhiana, alleging that she feels insecure at Mohali. It is averred that the respondent-husband is also facing another criminal complaint inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC at Ludhiana but this petition under Section 13 of the Act has been preferred by him at Mohali merely to harass, humiliate and dwarf her in her stature.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the circumstances explained in the petition and particularly when the husband is already facing a criminal complaint at Ludhiana, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 is ordered to be transferred from Mohali to the court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana. Compliance be made by the District & Sessions Judge, Mohali.

The petition stands disposed of.
