Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 (1)(i)(ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Rewari to Kurukshetra as the petitioner is residing alongwith her parents at Kurukshetra, which is more than 200 Kms. away from Rewari.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C as also petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and another petition for revision against interim order of petition under Section 125 Cr.PC against the respondent-husband, which are pending adjudication at Kurukshetra. Besides this, she has also filed a complaint, interalia, under Section 498-A IPC against the respondent-husband at Kurukshetra.

3. No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.
5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 (1)(i)(ia) of the Act pending before Additional District Judge, Rewari is transferred to District Judge, Kurukshetra. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.
6. Disposed of accordingly.
7. Copy Dasti on usual charges.
