In this petition, petitioner seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Ludhiana to Jalandhar as the petitioner is residing with her parents and two minor children aged about 4 and 2 years respectively at Jalandhar.

2. It is also urged she has submitted a complaint to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar and after enquiry, police registered FIR against the husband-respondent and his family members bearing FIR No.03 dated 08.01.2015, inter alia, under Section 498-A IPC at P.S. Women Cell, Jalandhar.

3. No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5.           Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Ludhiana is transferred to District Judge, Jalandhar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.
6.           Disposed of accordingly.
