There is a delay of 1522 days in filing the present regular second appeal against the concurrent findings of both the courts below, dismissing the suit of the plaintiff for permanent injunction.

The only ground taken before this court is that the appellant is a poor person and could not raise sufficient funds to engage the counsel.

In such eventuality, free legal aid services are available to the poor persons and this ground is no more available.

It being so, there are no sufficient ground to condone such huge delay of more than four years. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay is dismissed and as a result thereof, the regular second appeal also stands dismissed.
