In this petition, petitioner seeks transfer of petition under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Tarn Taran to Chandigarh as the petitioner is residing with her husband (Jatinderpal Singh with whom she performed second marriage) and one minor son at Chandigarh which is more than 300 Kms away from Tarn Taran.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner is a house hold lady and at this stage she is dependent on her husband-Jatinderpal Singh and she has no source of income.

3. No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as

also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 25 of the Act pending before Civil Judge (Senior Division), Tarn Taran is transferred to District Judge, Chandigarh. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
