Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 12 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short “the Act”) filed by the respondent-husband from Karnal to Ambala.

It is urged that the petitioner-wife has filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Ambala against the respondent who has been appearing. It is also urged that it is very difficult for petitioner-wife to travel 170 kilometers from Ambala to Karnal on each and every date of hearing. The petitioner has also filed an application for registration of a case against the respondent in pursuance of which respondent had appeared.

No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 12 of the Act pending before District Judge, Karnal is transferred to District Judge (Family Court) Ambala. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands allowed.
