Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short “the Act”) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of the marriage by decree of divorce from Moga to Ludhiana.

It is urged that the petitioner-wife has filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Ludhiana. Besides this, she has also filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Ludhiana. It is also urged that it is very difficult for petitioner to travel 70 kilometers from Ludhiana to Moga on each and every date of hearing.

No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and

further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before Additional District and Session Judge, Moga is transferred to District Judge, Ludhiana who may assign it to the court of competent jurisdiction. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands allowed.
