SNEH PRASHAR, J.

This petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure was filed by Smt. Mandeep Kaur-wife seeking transfer of the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent-husband from the court of District Judge, Barnala to Senior Sub Division, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the respondent submitted that as per instructions from the respondent he has no objection to the transfer of the petition from the Court of District Judge, Barnala to Senior Sub Division, Batala, District Gurdaspur as per prayer of the petitioner in the petition.

Otherwise also, as submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner, two other cases arising out of the marital discord between the parties are already pending at Batala. There is a small son aged 2 years born

out of the wedlock of the parties who is in custody of the petitioner. The distance between Batala and Barnala is more than 350 kilometers, so it will indeed be inconvenient for the petitioner to travel such a long distance alongwith the minor child to defend the petition filed by the respondent.

Accordingly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending before District Judge, Barnala is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to a court of competent jurisdiction at Gurdaspur. The file shall be sent by the trial court to the court of District and Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur within two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, who will either keep the petition himself/ herself or will entrust the same to any other court of competent jurisdiction at Batala, District Gurdaspur. The parties are directed to appear before the District Judge, Gurdaspur on 26.11.2015.
