Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of rent appeal filed by the petitioner before District Judge, Panipat acting as Appellate Authority under the Haryana Urban (Control of Rent & Eviction) Act, 1973 (for short, the Act) to competent Authority at Karnal by urging that the respondent and his father are practising Advocates at Panipat and as such, no lawyer is ready to accept the brief of the petitioner.

2. Counsel for the respondent, on the other hand, states that he has no objection in transferring the appeal but requests for early disposal of the same.

3. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

4. Sequelly, the rent appeal pending before District Judge, Panipat

acting as Appellate Authority under the Act is transferred to District Judge, Karnal, acting as Appellate Authority under the Act who shall decide the same preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order even by conducting day to day proceedings, if so required. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.
