Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce from Jalandhar to Amritsar.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 9 of the Act at Amritsar. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 85 kilometers from Amritsar to Jalandhar on each and every date of hearing.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Jalandhar is transferred to District Judge, Amritsar who may assign it to any competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 10.6.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
