Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Tarn Taran to Hoshiarpur.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing criminal proceedings inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC at Hoshiarpur. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to undertake journey of six hours from Hoshiarpur to Tarn Taran on each and every date of hearing.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Tarn Taran is transferred to District Judge, Hoshiarpur who may assign it to any competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 10.6.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
