Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) for dissolution of marriage by way of decree of divorce filed by the husband, respondent herein, at Hissar as the petitioner-wife is residing at Jind. It has been urged that the distance between Jind and Hissar is more than 80 Kms. and the petitioner-wife has a minor child of about 3 years and she herself is also doing job of a teacher in a school at village Julana which is near District Jind and far away from District Hissar. It is further urged that the petitioner-wife is living with her parents and she has also to take care of her ailing old parents and it is very difficult for her to manage and pursue the proceedings competently and effectively in the petition filed under Section 13 of the Act at Hissar by travelling from Jind to attend the dates of hearing in the said petition.

No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before District Judge, Family Court, Hissar is transferred District Judge, Family Court, Jind. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
