The present petition has been filed by the wife-petitioner for transfer of the case titled as “Naveen Kumar vs. Harpreet Kaur”, filed by the husband-respondent under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, from the court of Addl. District and Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur to the court of competent jurisdiction at Amritsar on the ground that a petition under the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 has already been dismissed as Amritsar.

It is stated that there is a distance of 72 Kms. from Gurdaspur to Amritsar. The parents of the wife-petitioner are old.

It is noticed that there is a direct train and bus service from Gurdaspur to Amritsar. It is a civil case, where the personal appearance of the petitioner is not required on each and every date.

It being so, merely because of the convenience of the petitioner, there is no ground to transfer the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from Gurdaspur court to Amritsar court.

Hence, dismissed.
