Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce from Ludhiana to Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar (SBS Nagar).

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is already facing proceedings under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005. It is further asserted that the petitioner is going to initiate proceedings for transfer of a petition under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act as also petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and criminal proceedings inter-alia under Sections 294 IPC etc. initiated at her instance at Ludhiana.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Ludhiana is transferred to District Judge, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar who may assign it to any competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 7.7.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
