Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) for restitution of conjugal rights filed by the husband, respondent herein, at Sri Muktsar Sahib as the petitioner-wife is residing at Bathinda and is regular student of D.A.V. College, Bathinda in Msc. I.T., 3rd Semester (Annexure P-1). It has been urged that the petitioner-wife finds threats to her life from the husband, respondent herein. If she contests the petition under Section 9 of the Act at Sri Muktsar Sahib, which has allegedly been filed by the husband merely to humiliate, harass and dwarf her as complaints have been made by her against him to the various authorities i.e. copies of DDR (Annexure P-6) and application to SHO, P.S. Kotwali, Bathinda (Annexure P-8).

No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as

also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sri Muktsar Sahib is transferred to District Judge, Bathinda. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
