In this petition, petitioner seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Dabwali to Sangrur as the petitioner is residing with her parents and one minor child aged about 2 ½ year respectively at Cinema Road, Sunam, Tehsil Sunam, District Sangrur which is approximately 110 Kms. away from Dabwali, District Sirsa.

It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication in the court at Sangrur. Besides this, she has also filed a Divorce Petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act at Sangrur and also moved a criminal complaint before the police to register a case under Section 406, 498-a IPC against the respondent and his family members.

No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Dabwali, District Sirsa is transferred to District Judge, Sangrur who may assign it to the court of competent jurisdiction. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
