Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the Rent petition No.1859 of 2010 filed under Section 13 of the East Punjab Rent Restrictions Act, 1949 by the petitioners has been decided by the learned Rent Controller and therefore this Transfer Application has become infructuous and be dismissed as such. He also submits that vide order dated 28.04.2015, District Judge, Chandigarh had imposed cost of Rs.20,000/- on the petitioners. The petitioners be given liberty to avail the remedy available under the law for impugning the order to that extent.
