Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 (1)(ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Nuh (Mewat) to Hisar as the petitioner is residing alongwith her parents and a minor son aged 5 years at Hansi, District Hisar, which is approximately 200 Kms. away from Nuh.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also got registered a case, interalia, under Section 498-A IPC against the respondent-husband and his family members at Hansi. Besides this, she has also instituted a petition under Section 125 Cr.PC against the respondent and in that case, the respondent is appeared at Hisar.

3. No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 13(1)(ia) of the Act pending before District Judge, Mewat at Nuh is transferred to District Judge, Hisar who may further assign the same to some other court of competent jurisdiction there. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
