Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Mansa to Phul, District Bathinda as the petitioner is residing alongwith her parents at village Bhai Rupa, Tehsil Phul, District Bathinda, which is approximately 90 Kms. away from Mansa.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also got registered a case, interalia, under Section 498-A IPC against the respondent-husband and his family members at Bathinda. Besides this, she has also instituted two petitions i.e. under Section 125 Cr.PC and under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 against the respondent-husband, which are pending adjudication in the court at Bathinda.

3. No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Mansa is transferred to District Judge, Bathinda who may further assign the same to some other court of competent jurisdiction at Phul. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
